VINEYARD: A twelve year old vineyard standing on a loamy soil with an east/west row direction and perfect exposure for ripening.

CLIMATE: Enough cold during the preseason ensured even budding. Moderate conditions prevailed during most of the harvest, with the exception a heat wave during the last week of January .Overall, very good conditions for ripening and harvesting.

HARVEST: Machine harvested from 2am to 9am into 4 ton bins, after we did grape selection in the vineyard.

WINEMAKING: Grapes harvested at 21 B, destemmed , crushed and only very clear juice are fermented with Vin 7 yeast in steel tanks at 13 C. After fermentation the wine was immediately racked of the lees, stabilized and bottled.
