GREAT EXPECTATIONS CHENIN BLANC



Pear drops and pineapple fruit on the nose follow through on a medium-bodied, well-balanced palate.

A thirteen-year-old vineyard standing on loamy soil with an east/west row direction and perfect exposure for ripening.

Enough cold during the preseason ensured even budding. Moderate conditions prevailed during most of the harvest with cool nights. Overall, the conditions are very good for ripening and harvesting.

Grapes harvested at 23 B, destemmed, crushed, and only very clear juice are fermented with Vin7 yeast in stainless steel tanks at 13°C. After fermentation, the wine was racked off the lees, stabilised, and bottled.

Light colour. Pear drops and pineapple fruit on the nose follow through on a medium-bodied, well-balanced palate. Good acidity ensures good length and freshness. Ideal with seafood.
